We will have 20 presentations and 2 keynotes by Diplom-Ingenieur Harald Wickenhäuser, retired from Rohde & Schwarz, and Professor Emeritus Eric E. Johnson of New Mexico State University.

On Wednesday August 17, we will have a panel on important long-term issues, with Samuel Ritchie of ComReg, as moderator: "What areas of research, standardisation and regulation are of the greatest interest to participants at HF16? What topics need to be pursued by industry, government, regulators and standardisation bodies and in what priority?"

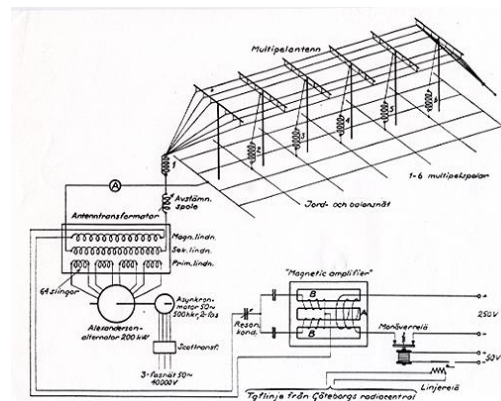
Please arrive Sunday August 14 in time (1700-2200) for the Rohde&Schwarz Bavarian buffet.

We remind you that flights from the Swedish mainland to Visby (VBY) are domestic; please retrieve your baggage when arriving in Sweden.

HF 16 buses will leave from Visby airport and harbour terminal on Sunday afternoon August 14. On Wednesday 17, an HF 16 bus will catch flights and ferries. Timings are on our website.

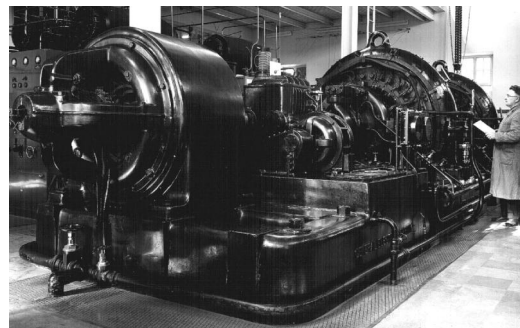
There will be no airport bus to Visby city. Avis, Hertz and Europcar have offices at VBY. Fårö Cab offers taxis from Visby to the venue: phone +46 (0) 498 223594 or email info@farocab.se.

There is limited public transport from Visby bus station to "Fårö church", very close to the camp (shuttle service from the harbour, then line 20). You may pay onboard (adult SEK 80, cash only). Most services terminate at Fårösund free ferry berth. If so, you have to walk onboard to be picked up by us on the Fårö side of the sound.
